Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be primary account holder and member in good standing.
- Must be attending or planning to attend college/university full-time.

Application Requirements:

Graduating High School Seniors:

- Official transcript (no photocopies) indicating cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA).
- Proof of full-time fall registration.

Current College Students:

- Official transcript (no photocopies) indicating cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of each college attended.
- Proof of full-time fall registration.

Award Criteria:

- Eligible applicants will be judged on their Grade Point Average (GPA).
- No applicant shall receive more than four scholarship awards.
